Scholarships for 2023

About

These scholarships will be offered to two Tasmanian students in their final year of school in 2022, who will be entering Jane Franklin Hall in 2023. While applicants must have received sound academic results from Year 11, the most important criteria for this scholarship are about demonstrating good character and the potential to contribute positively to the College community. Financial need is also considered.

As this is a prestigious award for Jane Franklin Hall, shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview with the College's Scholarships Committee, preferably in person in Hobart.

Applications close at

9:00am on 27th of September 2022



The Details

Value:

\$9,000 per year as a reduction of fees at Jane, for up to three years

Selection Criteria:

- Sound academic results from year 11
- Good character
- Potential to contribute positively to the diverse Jane community
- Financial need

Eligibility:

- For Tasmanian students who are completing school studies in 2022.
- For first year, undergraduate students who are enrolled at Jane Franklin Hall and the University of Tasmania for 2023.
- Not available to previous recipients of the scholarship.

To apply:

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. Forward via mail or email to Jane Franklin Hall with a copy of your Year 11 TCE results. Applications must be received **no later than 9.00am on 27th of September 2022.**
- 3. Shortlisted applicants will be invited for an interview in early October 2022.

The Selection Process

To be considered for a scholarship at Jane Franklin Hall, students must have applied for residency at Jane prior to **9.00am on 27th of September 2022.**

The Jane Franklin Hall Scholarships Committee will make decisions once interviews have been conducted and will make offers by late-October 2022.

The Committee's decisions are final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

All scholarship recipients must be residents at Jane in 2023. Withdrawal from the College will mean forfeiture of the scholarship. Unfortunately, due to the nature of funding for scholarships, deferrals of scholarships are not permitted.


