

Coming to Jane in 2025?

What to bring with you

Your room will have:

- a bed (single or long single)
- a mattress and mattress protector
- a desk
- a desk chair
- a wardrobe with drawers, or a separate chest of drawers
- a whiteboard
- a heater
- a mirror
- a rubbish bin

Unless you have purchased a linen pack from the College, you'll need to bring your own bedding (including pillows), towels and linen. You'll also need to bring coat hangers, laundry detergent and a laundry basket or bag to cart your things to the laundry.



Students generally like to bring items to make their rooms feel more homely. Some suggestions are:

- a lamp for your desk
- posters, photos and pictures
- an extra chair or a bean bag for friends to sit on
- a rug for your floor
- books
- pot plants
- mugs, glasses, teaspoons, plates, bowls (please no kettles or microwaves as tea and coffee making facilities are available in kitchenettes)
- cushions
- throw rugs
- a small bedside table

It gets chilly in Hobart in the winter, so make sure your bed coverings are warm and you have nice cosy jumpers and thick woolly socks for snugliness.

We encourage you to bring your own mugs, glasses, teaspoons, plates and bowls. We provide crockery in the dining hall, but over the year, it starts to go missing. It's one of our biggest bugbears! We want you to be able to grab a coffee, take a meal out on the lawn or have a cupcake back in your room - but please use your own crockery to do this and leave College crockery in the dining hall.

Some students bring a small bar fridge for their rooms or a TV. This is OK, but you'll need to have any electrical items tested and tagged by our Maintenance team before installing them. You can also bring an electric blanket, but you'll need to get it tested and tagged.

Some items are strictly forbidden for both safety and energy-saving reasons. These include fans, heaters, candles or any unapproved items (see your College Obligations and Terms of Residence (COTR) for more information)

Of course, you'll also bring clothes, toiletries, stationery and items for your studies.

Sports

Throughout the year, Jane students participate in a variety of sports. For this, many students may already have items for these sports at home. Below is a list of sports Jane students participate in and equipment you may like to bring for them.

Note:

You are not required to purchase these items. Just bring them along if you have them at home! The student club sports representatives have a multitude of bats, balls and gear to use for sports.

- Soccer: footy boots, shin pads, mouth guard (optional)
- AFL: footy boots, mouth guard (compulsory)
- Rugby: footy boots, mouth guard (compulsory)
- Cricket: cricket bat, pads, helmet, gloves
- Basketball: basketball shoes or sneakers
- Netball: netball shoes or sneakers
- Volleyball: sneakers
- Table tennis: table tennis bat
- Tennis/badminton: Tennis racquets or badminton racquets
- Surfing: surfboard
- Swimming: suitable swimwear for racing

Art events

The Jane Student Club holds a variety of arts events throughout the year. These include Jane's got Talent, Live at Jane, the Jane Art Show and the Jane Play. Students may like to bring the following items to participate in these events, or just for general enjoyment.

- Musical instruments: guitars, keyboards, etc.
