# Connecting to Jane Wi-Fi Windows OS Instructions

### **Overview**


The goal of this document is to outline how to connect to the Jane WiFi on a device running Windows OS.

## **Connecting a Windows OS device**


1. Right-click on your wireless network and choose "Open Network and Sharing Center"




2. Click on "Set up a new connection or network"




Jane Franklin Hall Version 1.2, 12/02/2016 3. Choose "Manually connect to a wireless network"




4. Enter the details: Network name is "Jane WiFi" without the quotes", set the Security type to be WPA2-Enterprise and click Next.




Jane Franklin Hall Version 1.2, 12/02/2016 6. Click on the "Change connection settings"




7. Click on the Security tab.




9. Turn off "Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate" Then click on "Configure..."




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10. Turn off "Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any) and click "OK", then click "OK".




## 11. Click on the "Advanced settings"

Tick "Specify authentication mode", choose "User authentication" and then click on "Save credentials



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12. Enter your "Jane WiFi" username and password details and click OK. Click "OK". Finally, click "Close".

You should now be connected to Jane Internet.
